B.Ed. (Secondary) 2.5 Years Program Description

The Bachelor of Education (B.Ed. Secondary) 2.5 years program at SZABIST aims to achieve high standards of teachers education. The emerging needs and shortage of human development resources mixed with higher qualities of leadership in the field of education at national level demand personnel who have sound professional and academic background in the field teacher education. This program provides such academic opportunities to those prospective teachers who may not have relevant educational background still enabling them with the art of teaching and managing teaching related issues. It aimed at providing education and training facilities to teachers, administrators and master graduates in the country

Program Mission

The program's mission is to help students' get familiar with the complexities of learning, human development, and sound pedagogical principles as well as develop a grounding in content knowledge and research.

It is a 90 credit hour program with 23 core courses, 4 content specialized courses, and 6 credit hours teaching practice, and 3 credit hours research project. The maximum time limit to complete the B.Ed. the degree is four years.

Admission Requirements

- For admission in B.Ed. (2.5-year) program, the candidate must have 14-years of education (B.A., B.Sc., B.Com, Associate Degree in Education (ADE) or equivalent) in any discipline with minimum Second Division/2.00 CGPA.
- Last degree verification from HEC is required.

B.Ed (Secondary) 1.5 Years

The Bachelor of Education (B.Ed. Secondary) 1.5 years program at SZABIST is intended to help pre-service and in-service teachers develop the required knowledge and skills to enter the educational sector as a competent and knowledgeable teacher with a grip on teaching different subjects in secondary grades in public and private sector. The proposed program has been specifically designed for students from non-educational background who want to now shift to serving and getting a degree in education. After the program completion, students will be eligible to apply for the MS/MPhil in Education.

Program Mission

B.Ed. program strives to prepare thoughtful, knowledgeable, lifelong learners who have extensive knowledge about working with students of various age groups and who understand the inherent richness of educational endeavors. The program's mission is to help students' get familiar with the complexities of learning, human development, and sound pedagogical principles as well as develop grounding in content knowledge and research. The program's goal is to prepare graduates who are committed to supporting just, engaging, and successful communities of diverse learners.

Program Objectives

The program aims to prepare skilled teachers through an intensive teacher education program. It will equip students not only with content and pedagogical knowledge and skills but also with research driven instructional practices.

Program Structure

B.Ed. (Secondary) is a 1.5 years degree program offered to pre-service and in-service teachers. It is a 54 credit hour program with 12 core courses (3 credit hours each), 4 content specialized courses (3 credit hours each), 3 credit hours teaching practice and 3 credit hours research project. The maximum time limit to complete the B.Ed. degree is four years.

Admission Requirements

- For admission in the B.Ed. program, the candidate must possess 16-years of Education (MA, M.Sc., M.Com. or equivalent) in any discipline with minimum Second Division/2.00 CGPA from a university recognized by HEC.
- Last degree verification from HEC is required.

MS in Educational Leadership and Management (Evening/Weekend)

The MS in Educational Leadership and Management Program at the Department of Education seeks to meet national and international standards of educational study and research. It is in conformity with the HEC guidelines and caters to the interests of a diverse set of learners who have chosen education to be their field of study. It prepares them for practical leadership roles with sound theoretical standing to make informed decisions.

Program Mission

The program aims to produce highly intellectual leaders and managers with influence on educational policy and reform. It envisages identifying challenges in global and local education, addressing issues in education through knowledge and research, and ultimately improving the standards of the prevailing educational system.

Program Structure

The MS in Education and Leadership and Management is 1.5-2 years program. It's a 30 credit hours' program in which two streams are available. One Stream is Course Work Based Stream and other one is Research Based Stream. In Course Work Stream, the student is required to complete 10 courses of 3 credit hours each. In the Research Based Stream, the student is required to complete 8 Courses (24 Credit Hours) and Two IRS (6 Credit Hours) OR One Thesis (6 Credit Hours). In both the streams, 30 Credit hours to be completed.

The students will have the opportunity to specialize in the fields of Sociology of Education, Educational Policy, Testing and Evaluation, Teacher Education, Professional Development, School Administration/Educational Leadership, Guidance & Counseling, Curriculum development, Technology Integration in Education, Early Childhood Education, Higher Education studies, Educational Psychology and Child Development.

Admission Requirements

- For admission in MS (ELM), the candidate must posses 16-years of education in the discipline of Education. Or 16-years of education along with B.Ed* with minimum second division/2.0 CGPA from an HEC recognized institution.
- GAT General/HAT relevant with minimum 50% score is also required.
- Last degree verification from HEC is required.

*Candidates applying with a 1-year BEd. Degree are required to complete 6 bridging courses of 18 credits at SZABIST.
